Ms Winnie CHIU Wai-yin was appointed by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as the Ombudsman Hong Kong for a term of five years commencing on April 1, 2019 in accordance with The Ombudsman Ordinance. Prior to her appointment, Ms Chiu has served in the Hong Kong Police Force for over 36 years and risen through the ranks to Deputy Commissioner. She has accumulated rich experience in investigation, operations, policy planning, organisational governance and strategic management. She also possesses outstanding skills in leadership and communication. As the first female Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ms Chiu commands respect and is well recognised both in the Government and in the community. She was awarded the Hong Kong Police Medal for Meritorious Service in 2010 and the Hong Kong Police Medal for Distinguished Service in 2017.

Ms Chiu holds a Master of Business Administration, Master of Science in Training and Human Resource Management and Diploma in Public Administration. She has also attended executive programmes at the Harvard Kennedy School, Tsinghua University, Fudan University, Chinese Academy of Governance and Australian Institute of Police Management.

Ms Chiu has a strong sense of justice and fairness. She is committed to tackling maladministration and improving the public administration in Hong Kong.
