

Help Promote Fair, Open and Effective Public Administration Join the Office of The Ombudsman

Established under The Ombudsman Ordinance, Cap. 397 of the Laws of Hong Kong, the Office of The Ombudsman is an independent statutory body dedicated to monitoring public administration in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. Through independent, objective and impartial investigation, we redress grievances and address issues arising from maladministration in the public sector and bring about improvement in the quality and standard of and promote fairness in public administration.

Applications are now invited for the following position:

Assistant Investigation Officer

Roles and Responsibilities

The job holder will be responsible for duties including, but not limited, to the following:

- (1) To act as a Case Officer to manage the full cycle of complaint processing, including examining and assessing complaints, conducting inquiries, mediation and investigation, carrying out site visits/inspections, scrutinising and analysing information/evidence, interviewing informants/witnesses, preparing draft correspondence, replies and reports, announcing investigation reports, following up on the implementation of recommendations, etc.;
- (2) To act as Duty Officer on a rotational basis by receiving complainants, answering enquiries, taking telephone, etc.;
- (3) To man the reception counter and hotline on a rotational basis; and
- (4) To facilitate the promotion of the work of the Office by participating in public education and publicity programmes/activities.

Entry Requirements

- (1) Unquestionable integrity and conduct;
- (2) A recognised degree from a Hong Kong university or equivalent;
- (3) A good command of spoken and written Chinese (including conversational Putonghua) and English;
- (4) A good team player capable of delivering results independently and owning a strong sense

- of time management;
- (5) Profound interpersonal, analytical and communication skills;
 - (6) Knowledge of Microsoft Office particularly Chinese and English word processing; and
 - (7) Possession of qualifications/experience related to investigation and/or mediation will be an advantage.

Shortlisted candidates will be required to take a written test.

(Current final-year university students are welcome to apply. If selected, their appointments will be subject to the production of proof of the required academic qualifications. Commencement of their service will be in July/August 2026.)

Remuneration and Terms

A competitive remuneration and benefits package, which includes a basic salary of around **HK\$35,000** plus **HK\$2,300** cash allowance per month at current levels, paid annual leave, general holidays, medical and dental insurance, life and disability insurance and MPF, 5-day work week, etc., will be offered. The successful candidate will be appointed on contract terms generally of three years. Subject to satisfactory performance, a gratuity will be payable on completion of the contract, which, when added to the employer's contribution to a Mandatory Provident Fund scheme, equals 15% of the total basic salary for the contract period. Subject to service needs and staff performance, renewal of contract will be considered.
